

CLASSES FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH

- **Nursery** (Birth to Age 2)
Our babies and toddlers are lovingly cared for by Kyla Brooks and volunteers in a bright, colorful, child-friendly environment. Open during the Sunday School hour and both Sunday worship services, the nursery is located behind the church office area, right next to the library.
- **Pre-K/Grade 1** (Ages 3-7)
Preschool and early elementary children will love learning about God's love for them, favorite Bible stories, and the life of Jesus. Lessons may include a Bible story, crafts, games, and snacks. The primary classroom is located in the Christian Education Wing, and teachers are Barbara Bancroft and Gina McKenney.
- **Juniors** (Grades 2-5)
This class welcomes children in grades two through five, with a focus on learning to use the Bible and application of Bible lessons to daily life. It may include Bible stories, crafts, and snacks. The junior room is located in the Christian Education Wing, and the teachers are Robin Blanchard and Dana Hatton.
- **Middle School** (Grades 6-8)
Russ and Cindy Johnson help these youth learn to integrate their faith into their daily life using the Deep Blue for Tweens curriculum. The middle school room is located in the Christian Education Wing.
- **High School** (Grades 9-12)
The High School Class uses the Bible Lessons for Youth curriculum, designed to help youth understand scripture and apply it to their individual experiences. They will meet in the Worship and Wonder room. Teachers are Cathy Vaden and Diane Clark.

CLASSES FOR ADULTS

- **The Parlor Class**



This class will be using the book You Can't Ask That!: 50 Taboo Questions about the Bible, Jesus, and Christianity by Christian Piatt, which tackles 50 of the most provocative, challenging, and hard-to-answer questions about faith and religion with thoughtful responses from today's top religion professors, pastors, and other faith leaders on the topics. This class will meet in the Sojourner's Room, and will be taught by Danny Simmons, Jamie McDonald, and Cassie Price.

- **The Fellowship Class**



Join a diverse group of individuals and couples who come together to study the Bible. The Bible lessons in this quarter unify around the theme, "Respond." The lessons move through various responses people of faith are called to make as they live out their faith in both good times and difficult ones. The Fellowship Class meets in the Christian Education wing, and is taught by Kitten Whitlow.

- **The Sojourners Class**

The atmosphere of this class is non-threatening, non-judgmental—a feeling of love and respect for each participant's questions or expressed beliefs prevails. The class will start the year with the Gospel According to Matthew using Barkley's Commentary, taught by Cathy Law, Sara Reese, and Susan Deihl. - **Worship and Wonder**

Following the Children's Message each Sunday at our worship services, pre-school through third grade children are invited to attend a supervised "Worship & Wonder" study session in our Worship and Wonder classroom in the Christian Education wing. - **Wednesday Evening Prayer and Fellowship**
